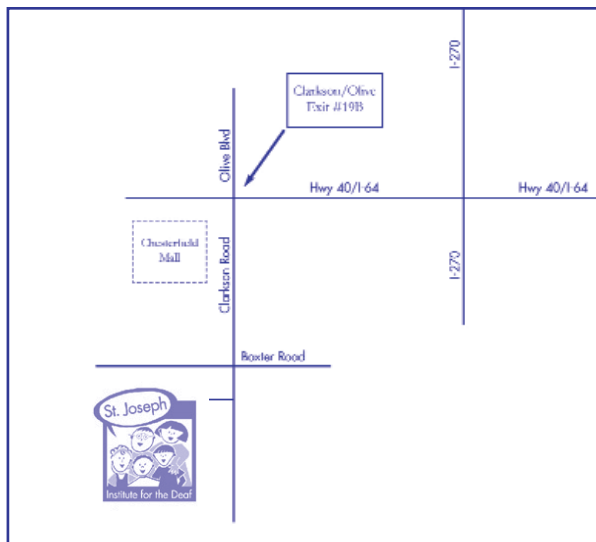


Reasons to have your hearing tested:

- Others complain you have the television too loud
- You are missing things you once enjoyed (birds chirping, music)
- You have difficulty hearing female voices or children
- You have difficulty hearing in groups
- You sometimes confuse words or misunderstand conversations
- Friends and family are concerned about what you might be missing
- Hearing loss is present in three out of every 10 adults between the ages of 50 and 64 and in four out of every 10 adults over age 65

Reasons to have your child's hearing tested:

- Child is not startled by loud sounds
- Child does not turn toward sounds
- Lack of babbling/vocal play after six months
- Difficulty locating sounds
- Speech that is difficult to understand, too loud, or too soft
- Frequent or recurrent ear infections
- Appears inattentive or withdraws

Tests available include:

- Pure tone audiometry
- Tympanometry
- Acoustic reflexes and reflex decay
- Otoacoustic emissions
- Speech understanding in quiet and noise
- Real ear measurements
- Functional gain testing
- Cochlear implant evaluations

Services available include:

- Cochlear implant counseling
- Hearing aid and cochlear implant programming
- Hearing aid and cochlear implant supplies
- Selection of assistive listening devices such as FM systems

Our center offers a full range of state-of-the-art amplification devices, from small in-the-canal hearing aids to the most powerful hearing instruments available. The St. Joseph Institute Audiology Center specializes in 100% digital technology. Devices are selected and programmed given the specific needs of each individual and various listening situations. Assistive listening devices and supplies are also available for purchase.
